
Go on a Lichen Hunt


You can go on a lichen hunt almost anywhere. Why not see what you can find around **where you live** and compare that with a **park** or **wood**?

You will have to **look carefully**, sometimes lichens are very small. If you have a **magnifying glass**, take that on your hunt so you can have a really close look at what you find.



Lichens come in different shapes. They can be crusty, bushy or leafy. They grow on all sorts of surfaces but for now, find a tree and look for them on the trunk or branches. Answer the questions in this key to decide which kind of lichen you are looking at.

The lichen sticks up from the bark it is growing on.

Now take a good look around the rest of the area you are in for lichens. Remember – they can grow on both man-made and natural surfaces. Write down where you find them in this table:
