Common Bird's-foot-trefoil

Lotus corniculatus

Often grows low to the ground and has clusters of yellow flowers with bits of red. The leaves have 5 narrow oval leaflets and the bottom two are bent back.



Common Knapweed

Centaurea nigra

It looks like a similar to a thistle, with a round black or brown head topped with sharp purple, pink, or sometimes white spikes.



Creeping Buttercup

Ranunculus repens

Its shiny yellow flowers are made up of 5 petals. The leaves are hairy and split into 3 parts. It spreads by creeping along the ground, unlike other buttercups.



Cuckooflower

Cardamine pratensis

This plant has delicate flowers made of 4 pale pink or white petals. The leaves grow along a stalk in pairs, and the ones close to the ground form a circle.



Germander Speedwell

Veronica chamaedrys

It has bright blue flowers with a white centre. The leaves have tiny teeth along the edges and feel hairy. You can see hairs on the stems in two neat rows.



Herb Robert

Geranium robertianum

This plant looks much prettier than it smells, which isn't very nice! It grows low on the ground with reddish stems. It has small pink flowers with 5 petals.



Oxeye Daisy

Leucanthemum vulgare

Looks like a big daisy with white petals and a yellow centre. It grows on a tall stem, up to 70cm tall. The leaves are dark green and shaped like spoons.



Selfheal

Prunella vulgaris

It has big blue-purple flowers that grow close together at the top of the stem.
The diamond-shaped leaves are hairy and have tiny teeth along the edges.



Yellow Rattle

Rhinanthus minor

Spikes grow up to 50cm tall with yellow tube-like flowers that have 2 lips. The leaves are narrow, jagged, and grow in pairs and the stem has black spots.
